## City and Community Partners celebrate beginning of work on upgrades to Our Redeemer's Lutheran Church

**WHAT:** Our Redeemer's building is the product of at least three major building projects over the span of 71 years. Over the years the congregation's needs and priorities have evolved and the church's Vision Aligned Building (VAB) Team is creating a design that uplifts rather than restricts what can be done in the building. <u>SHKS Architects</u> has designed a space that is true to the vision outlined in 2016, will meet the daily needs of the congregation and community, and corrects known life/safety problems with the building. Elements include:

- 1. Flexible worship space that uplifts and enhances formal and informal and invites in the community.
- 2. Accessible spaces and an environment that fosters community and expresses our diversity.
- 3. Office space that is more functional, collaborative and volunteer friendly.

<u>LZL Construction</u> is the contractor for the project which will take 10 months to complete.
