


*We see that love and giving always come together.

...helps us *grow in faith and be part of something bigger than ourselves*. When we pledge, we make an intentional decision about our faith and service. Making a pledge says, "I want to have (be) a church."

...assists in *establishing values and priorities*. When we give each month we demonstrate our priorities and establish habits that honor what is most important to us.

...creates *stability and predictability* for our congregation and alleviates the anxiety of needing to repeatedly ask for contributions to keep expenses under control.

## How much should I pledge?

The Bible gives us the tithe (10% of our income) as a starting place. God is our loving Creator, who invites us into the adventure of giving because giving makes us more whole and makes the world more whole. Some people work toward tithing by adding one half to one percent every year.

## What happens if I can't make my pledge?

Your pledge is a gift, not an obligation. You can change it at any time.

## What is the new pledge period?

January 1 through December 31.

## What giving methods are available?

You can give in whatever way is best for you: cash, check, Paypal, automatic withdrawals, text, giving app or credit card.

## If I am not giving electronically, how do I make my gift?

Offering envelopes will be mailed to you once a month. You can place your gift in the offering plate as part of worship, or you can send your gift by mail in the enclosed return envelope.

## How do I make my gifts by cash or check?

Place your gift in the offering plate, or mail it in the enclosed return envelope.

## How can I be part of the offering during worship if I give electronically?

You can find a giving card in the pew racks and place it in the offering plate.

## Why are there special envelopes just for my offering?

For privacy. Your gift is confidential because the envelope identifies you by number, not name. Your name and gift are seen only by the Financial Secretary and the Parish Administrator who record your giving for tax purposes, and by a volunteer who compiles aggregate information for the Church Council, Finance Team and Stewardship Team.

## How can I stay consistent in my giving when I'm away from worship?

Automatic withdrawals, recurring gifts through the Giving App and using your offering envelopes through the mail help with that.

## How often will I receive a statement of my giving?

Quarterly statements of cumulative giving are issued in April, July, October, and January.
