Position Summary

Our Redeemer's Lutheran Church is an open and affirming community of faith trusting in God's unconditional grace. We experience and celebrate the love of God as people of every race, ethnic background, social status, physical condition, sexual orientation, and gender identity. We seek to be a community in the model of Christ through our commitment to compassion, transforming spirituality, community, and justice for all.

Our Redeemer's is at a critical and exciting place of growth and development. The most important calling, and the biggest challenge of any church is to share the good news of Jesus Christ in a way that everyone can hear and be transformed by it. In a highly secular culture with many ways of garnering information, this can be a daunting task. Our Communications Coordinator understands both church and secular culture, and is passionate about bridging the gap. This person inspires, informs, and invites an increasing number of people to participate in our programs and activities, breaking through negative stereotypes of church and religion.

Job Responsibilities

- Maintain a comprehensive communication plan for the church, its activities and initiatives. Includes a calendar/schedule of events and deadlines to create publications and rally our staff.
- Manage the production of marketing collateral that expresses our voice, aligns with our identity, and effectively conveys our message and ministry.
- Collaborate with staff, and work with volunteers and vendors on a wide range of media efforts. Digital includes: our website, FaceBook, Instagram, podcasts, and blog posts. Print includes: postcards, bulletins, announcements, newsletters, mailings, brochures, signage, banners, and booklets.
- Develop content on subject matter relating to equity, race, diversity, faith, and social justice, building great writing quickly and for multiple channels. Writing, photography and graphic design are implemented as well.

Compensation

The wage of \$20-22/hour at 30 hours per week is base pay. Scheduled time is considered somewhat flexible, allowing regular hours to collaborate with staff and volunteers, including weekly staff and supervisory meetings. Benefits include two weeks of paid vacation time per year, and two weeks of sick leave, and 12 paid holidays.

Culture

Our ministry team shares a passion for God, community life, and social justice. Our shorthand for God's story among us is "transformative spirituality in action." God is constantly transforming us, calling us to live our faith – however imperfectly. As a congregation, we trust that God's unconditional grace empowers us to be a source of hope and a force for positive change, in our lives and the life of the world. That said, we are not monolithic in our beliefs, creating space for diversity of thought and belief among us and around us.
